8. Discuss a therapeutic relationship and examine possible negative outcomes

The course has 11 questions that professionals must ask that require self-reflection and introspection

At the end of the workshop, the student will be able to describe and clarify ethical boundaries. The student will be able to develop tools to use if boundaries are in question and develop a practical approach to deal with common ethical problems. We will also use the NCBTMB Code of Ethics to recommit to the patient and to the profession in the.
